### 1. Programs and Seats Available

### 2. Eligibility

The following individuals are eligible to apply:

- (1) Individuals who were conferred a degree which is equivalent to Master's degree or professional degree by an educational institution in a foreign country, or who will be conferred said degree by March 31, 2027.
- (2) Individuals who are recommended by a professor of the university from which they have graduated
- (3) Individuals who have obtained private consent from a professor of KIT

### 3. Selection

Selection is conducted comprehensively, based on application documents and an oral examination.

A presentation and oral examination based on the master's thesis topic and research plan.

- (2) Documents to be submitted

1. Application form (form specified by KIT)
2. Payment slip (form specified by KIT)
3. Applicant record (form specified by KIT)
4. Recommendation (form specified by KIT)
5. Diploma of Bachelor's Degree
6. Undergraduate course transcript
7. Master's course transcript
8. Certificate of Master's Degree or certificate indicating a Master's Degree is to be conferred
9. Summary of the Master's thesis or research report (published theses and/or research results)  
(Japanese: approx. 2,000 characters or English: approx. 1,500 words.)

- (3) Examination fee: 30,000 yen

- (4) The examination fee and submitted documents shall not be returned.

## 7. Admission Procedures

- (1) Admission procedures shall be completed by payment of the admission fee by the payment deadline.

- (2) Admission fee: 250,000 yen

- (3) The admission fee and submitted documents shall not be refunded.

- (4) Admission procedure documents will be sent with the notification of acceptance. Please submit the documents by the deadline.
